If you have taken a relevant class as a student, please encourage your professor to submit these materials and/or let the INEE Secretariat know and we will reach out to request approval for posting the information.

The Academic Space on the INEE website provides an opportunity for academics to share their work with INEE members as well as the broader community working in the education in emergencies and post-crisis reconstruction field. Other types of work, such as theses, dissertations, integrated projects, monographs, conference papers, and/or journal articles, can also be submitted to network@ineesite.org.
